Important information for your day trip to Innsbruck

Innsbruck – the characteristics:

- This tour takes you to Innsbruck, the **fifth largest city** in Austria. This city is so beautiful and important that we recommend not to connect the tour with other destinations but dedicate the whole excursion to this magnificent city.
- A tour where you are **completely free** in planning
- **No pressure** due to admission times
- No pre-booked tickets required
- **Pure city experience** in the most relaxed way
- **Proverbial spontaneity!** Just decide on site what you want to see and do

Booking: You book the tour on your desired date - we will do the rest!

- **Departure times** from Munich between **08:00** and **09:30** (**the sooner the better especially during high season!**)
- A visit to the **Swarovski Kristallwelten** in Wattens (just before Innsbruck) is optional. If you would like to go there, we recommend a visit **on the way** to Innsbruck

The ride to Innsbruck:

- Due to the **Schengen Agreement**, there are usually no border controls
- There are usually **no waiting times** at the border
- Nothing prevents you from enjoying the journey through the picturesque **Bavarian foothills** to the high-alpine mountains around Innsbruck

Top Highlights in Innsbruck:

- Twice the venue of the **1964** and **1976 Winter Olympics!** A visit to the Bergisel with the famous ski jump is always worthwhile
- A visit to the **"Goldenes Dachl"** (golden roof) with its 2.657 fire-gilded copper shingles from the beginning of the Renaissance is the town's landmark and a must see on the walk through the historic old town
- Castle fans will be delighted by the **Innsbruck Hofburg** and the baroque courtyard garden. Here Empress Maria Theresia seems to have just stepped out of the garden
- **Mountain fan?** Just take a train and a **cable car** directly from the city to Innsbruck's local mountain Hafelekar with Europe's highest alpine **zoo**

- Please pay attention to **suitable footwear** and inform yourself in advance about the weather on the day of your visit to Innsbruck.
