

Hygiene concept for city tours in Munich

To protect you and us...

... the following applies to city tours with an incidence value below 50 (as of June 16, 2021)

- the number of participants is limited to 15
- observance of the minimum distance of 1.5 - 2 meters for all guests not belonging to one household
- recording of contact data in compliance with data protection regulations
- **New:** the mask obligation in the Munich old part of town is abolished since 9 June 2021! Thus, there is also no longer a mask requirement for city tours. Having a mask with you at any time is recommended
- **New:** Due to the positive incidence situation in Munich, it is no longer necessary to bring a negative daily corona test for city tours

Simple Corona rules

- Keep **1,5 - 2 meters distance** to others whenever possible!
- **Wash your hands** thoroughly!
- You must wear a **mask** on most streets in the inner city. Pay attention to the signs!
- You must wear an **FFP2 mask** on **public transportation** and while waiting on stops.
- You must wear an **FFP2 mask** in **shops** and **supermarkets**.
- If you develop any **symptoms** make an appointment with a doctor and have yourself tested as soon as possible
