

Hygiene concept for city tours in Munich

To protect you and us...

... the following applies to city tours (as of March 2022)

- the number of participants for **tours on the outside** is **limited to 25**
- the number of participants for **tours inside buildings** is varying, but **usually limited to 10**
- for all **tours** the **3G rule** applies -> **fully vaccinated** or **recovered** or **tested** (negative test - PCR test not older than 48h / rapid test not older than 24h) documented via an app on a cell phone, or written confirmation from the testing center
- if possible, keep a distance of 1.5 - 2 meters for guests not belonging to one household
- recording of contact data in compliance with data protection regulations
- for guided tours outdoors: it is recommended to wear an FFP2 mask if the distance cannot be maintained
- for guided **tours indoors**, the wearing of an **FFP2 mask is obligatory**

Simple Corona rules

- Keep **1,5 - 2 meters distance** to others whenever possible!
- **Wash your hands** thoroughly!
- In **public transport** and **cabs**, the 3G rule applies: vaccinated, recovered, or tested
- You must wear an FFP2 mask on public transport and when waiting at bus stops
- In stores and supermarkets, you must wear an FFP2 mask.
- If you develop symptoms, see a doctor, and get tested as soon as possible
